Gift Aid

The **Gift Aid** scheme allows us to reclaim from HM Revenue & Customs the tax which has already been paid on donations - last year we claimed over £3,700. If you are a taxpayer all you have to do is **download** and complete a declaration confirming that we may reclaim the tax you have paid. Higher rate taxpayers can claim further relief via their own tax return. Declarations may be cancelled at any time on receipt of your written instruction.

Giving through your Self-Assessment return

If you complete a Self-Assessment tax return you are now able to nominate a charity to receive all or part of any repayment due to you. If you would like to nominate the Festival to receive your tax repayments as a donation you will need to enter our unique code on your tax return. The Code is **AAJ57SG**.
